This summer Pratham is offering a unique opportunity for students to take part in a 12-day immersive Youth Leadership Program that combines community service and cultural immersion in a safe and enjoyable environment at the 'Pratham Arora Centre for Education' near Aurangabad, India.

The program is a remarkable opportunity to experience first-hand Pratham's world-famous education and learning programs and gain a deep understanding of Indian culture.

About the Program

Youth Leaders will gain a broad understanding of Pratham's program functions along with insights into the broader context of Pratham's work. In addition, Youth Leaders will gain valuable teaching and leadership experience, and gain new perspectives on contemporary social issues in India.

Participants will stay at the 'Pratham Arora Centre for Education' near Aurangabad where they will be exposed to a variety of

Pratham's activities including vocational training, technology-based initiatives as well as community and school-based programs. Youth Leaders will interact with Pratham beneficiaries of all ages through individual teaching and classroom activities.

In addition, field trips to local communities and sites of interest in the nearby areas will be incorporated, along with a range of fun team, cultural and outdoor activities.



Age

The program is open to students between the ages of 16 and 19 years old.

Housing

Participants will stay at the Pratham Arora Centre for Education in Khultabad, Maharashtra, a short distance from Aurangabad with air/rail connections to major cities in India.

Visas

Applicants are responsible for procuring a visa. Pratham will work with accepted applicants to assist them in completing the necessary paperwork.

Program Costs

\$2,800 including food and accommodation, local transport and activities. Airfare is not included in the estimate.

Duration

The program runs from July 23 to August 4, 2023.

How to apply

Applicants should submit a resume/curriculum vitae and a short essay (max 300 words) describing their interest in and motivation to participate in the program to youthleaders@prathamusa.org.

Deadline: April 22, 2023.

Following an initial review, shortlisted applicants will be interviewed. Spots will be filled on a first-come, first-approved basis.
